Leighton Contractors receives a further \$150 million for Chevron's Gorgon LNG Jetty and Marine Structures project

Leighton Contractors, in consortium with Saipem, have been awarded a further \$150 million towards the existing contract to build the LNG Jetty and Marine Structures on Chevron's Gorgon project.

The Saipem Leighton Consortium has been issued a variation for work relating to the design, fabrication and installation of Pre Assembled Racks (PARs) for the 2.1 kilometre LNG Jetty, in addition to the original \$900 million dollar scope.

The PAR design, fabrication, transport and installation will be integrated into the existing Gorgon Jetty project design and construction process. Design of the PARs has already commenced and fabrication is likely to start in late 2010, with installation works to be complete by late 2013.

The original scope of work consists of the design, material supply, fabrication, construction and commissioning of the LNG Jetty. Construction is scheduled to commence in early 2011 on Barrow Island, 70 kilometres off the Pilbara coast of Western Australia.
